Each piece is hand drawn by Ahern, who takes into consideration both the environment surrounding the piece and the vision of the client when creating his designs. Ahern's use of the interior and exterior of the available space allows him to design work that connects to both existing architecture the environment. Each of his organic designs is unique, one-of-a-kind and never replicated.

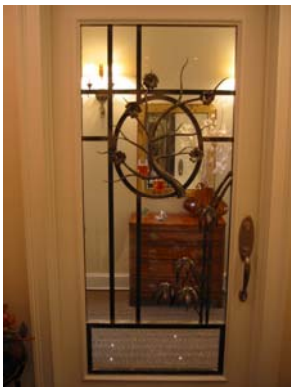
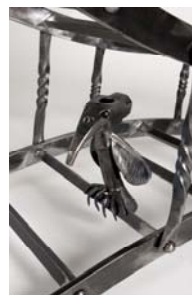
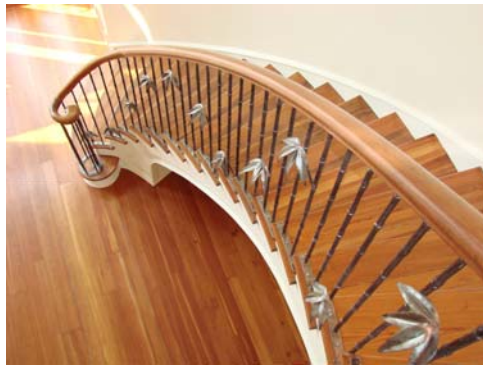
Sean Ahern was born in Charleston in 1976. His love of the arts began at a very young age when he found himself constantly sketching and building objects. Ahern moved to Georgia to study at **Atlanta College of Art**, where his first stone sculpture class inspired him to pursue a degree in the arts. Focusing more on sculptural and three-dimensional arts and concentrating in the mediums of bronze and iron, Ahern's inspiration became the beauty of natural elements. He worked to incorporate the organic shapes and movements of his surroundings into his artwork. After graduating in 1998, Ahern apprenticed with local artists in Atlanta, further developing his appreciation. He journeyed to Saint Etienne, France, to study at the renowned **L'Ecole des Beaux-Arts**, where he assisted professors in the building of the sculptural arts department. Ahern became inspired by French ironwork, which is historically renowned for its detail and creative designs. Subsequent to his training in France, Ahern returned to the States to officially begin his metalworking career.

Ahern's Anvil opened in North Charleston in 2002 and in 2006, the company moved to a 3,000 square foot workshop on Brigade Street in Charleston. Under Ahern's guidance and creative talent, Ahern's Anvil is quickly becoming the premier metalwork studio in the Southeast.
